FALL FESTIVAL AND FIDDLER'S CONTEST IN 34TH YEAR

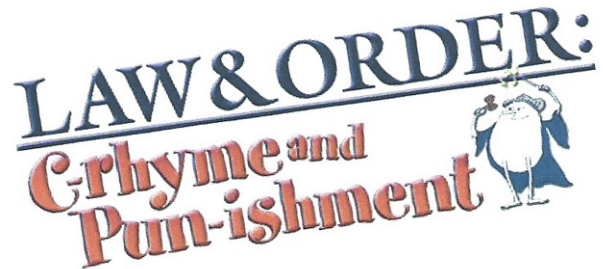
